


General Power-Up

- 1. Turn down MASTER and other VOLUME controls and set BASS and TREBLE to the 12 o'clock position
- 2. Connect all wired inputs that will be needed to the amplifier (see sections below)
- 3. Switch the POWER button to the ON position (if the POWER LED is not lit, check the mains supply)
- 4. Gradually increase MASTER and other VOLUME controls to the required level.
- 5 After use, turn down MASTER, switch POWER off and remove all connections and retract antenna

Wired microphones

- Connect 1 or 2 microphones to INPUT 1 or 2 via jack or XLR
- 2. Set the slide switch on each microphone channel to MIC
- 3. If a condenser microphone requires phantom power, set the slide switch to PHANTOM
- 4. Turn MASTER up
- Gradually increase each VOLUME and check for output through speakers



Wireless microphone

- Extend the UHF Antenna fully (do not close the door whilst extended)
- 2. Ensure handset has 2 x AA batteries installed
 - Slide up switch on the handheld microphone to the ON position
- 4. Turn MASTER up
- . Gradually increase UHF MICROPHONE volume and check for output through speakers

Media Player and Line Inputs

- 1. For Bluetooth connection, press the MODE button until the display shows "Bluetooth". Search for device ID "Bluetooth" and connect
- 2. For playback of mp3 files from USB or SD card, insert the media into the player and use the buttons beneath the display to navigate
- 3. A smartphone, laptop or mp3 player can be connected to AUX 1 and controlled by the MEDIA volume control
- 4. AUX 2 can accept a line input (CD player, DVD player, TV box computer etc.) and is independent of the media player
- 5. Other mono line inputs can be connected to INPUT 1 or 2 by setting the slide switch to LINE
